
Survey Background and Overview

- In December 2012, AFTLD(Africa), APTLD (Asia Pacific), CENTR (Europe) and LACTLD (Latin America) all published the same set of questions to their full members the A-Level Survey 2012.
- The Survey: 70 questions on a broad range of topics such as; Legal structures, Registration policy, pricing, Registrar interactions, Data protection/Whois, IDNs and DNSSEC etc
- Across the 3 regions, a total of 86 Registry Operators took part in the survey


Strong conclusion – "Despite the big geographical, language and cultural differences, ccTLD operators around the world have a lot in common!"

For profit or not-for profit




Top 3 most common registration periods




Observed similarities

Prohibited or Sensitive Name list




"The most common category on restricted lists are **geographical names**"

DNSSEC implemented




Other observations from survey


- -Percentage of members who offer direct registrations: 70% LACTLD, 30% APTLD, 50% CENTR
- -Across all 3 regions there are just 3 Registries who act as Registrars for gTLDs.
- -Percent of members which take less than an hour to have a registered domain visible in the DNS: APTLD: 53%, CENTR, 61% and LACTLD 75%
